9. Obtaining permission from Answers in Genesis ministry to use the words "Creation Museum" in our title.
10. Holding creation meetings and seminars.

Now the work really begins! We must pray in faith with a steadfast spirit. We must expect God to help us every step of the way and know that we are totally dependent upon Him. The Scriptures that come to mind are:
