HOW WELL DO WE KNOW THE BIBLE?

"Just because you put a Holy Book in people's hands...it does not mean they will understand it...the United States...is saturated with Bibles—Americans buy more than twenty million new ones every year to add to the four that sit in the average American house. Yet the state of American biblical knowledge is abysmal. One Gallup survey found that fewer than half of Americans can name the first book of the Bible (Genesis), only a third know who delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Billy Graham is a popular answer), and a quarter do not know what is celebrated at Easter (the Resurrection, the foundational event of Christianity). Sixty percent cannot name half the Ten Commandments; 12 percent think Noah was married to Joan of Arc. George Gallup, a leading Evangelical as well as a premier pollster, describes America as 'a nation of biblical illiterates'" (Quoted from *God is Back*, by Mick-lethwait and Wooldridge, The Penguin Press, New York, 2009, p. 268).

I believe it is sadly true that for decades we have seen Americans raised with little or no biblical knowl-

edge. I often think of the young men who went on the deadly shooting spree in a Colorado High School a few years ago. They were not able to see written anywhere in their school the biblical command, "Thou shalt not kill." Instead, not believing in God, they had been taught and believed they were descended from lower forms of animals—the product of evolution over millions of years. They even chose the birthday of one of their heroes for their savage attack—Adolf Hitler!

Is there a need for a creation museum/ministry in Branson, Missouri, with its millions of visitors each year? Absolutely, and we will continue to believe in God for the land and finances needed to provide this facility.

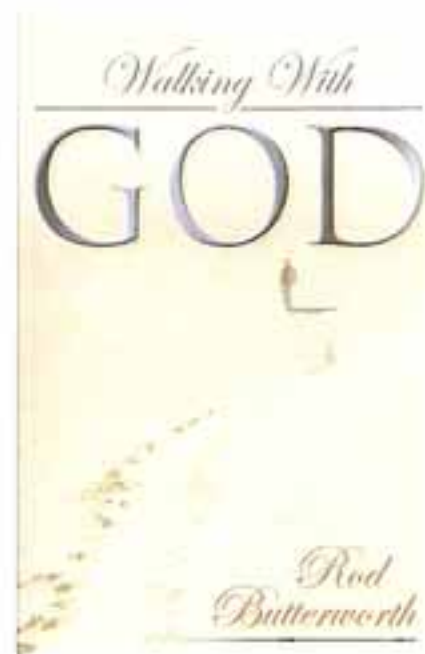

“CREATION MATTERS”

Radio ministry of *Creation Museum of the Ozarks*

Many will not have had the opportunity to hear our daily Monday through Friday radio broadcasts on KLFC Radio covering the Branson, Missouri, area. Vice President of CMOTO Barry Dullum introduces our two-minute spots, and I, Rod Butterworth begin to talk about an issue related to creation and evolution. They go as follows:

BARRY: This is your host Barry Dullum for “Creation Matters” with Dr. Rod Butterworth for the ministry of *Creation Museum of the Ozarks*.

ROD, what are your thoughts about the recent attacks against Christianity from atheists?

ROD: Well, Barry, I’ve read some of the books put out by those claiming to be atheists, such as Dr. Richard Dawkins’ book, “The God Delusion.” To me it is not surprising that these attacks are coming fast and furious, and one of the reasons for this is that truly the scientific evidence for an intelligent Creator who created all things is increasing as time passes.

One might ask the question, “If these atheists claim there is no God, why are they spending so much effort to attack someone who they loudly proclaim doesn’t exist?” Well, when we examine their basic beliefs and world view, we discover that they believe in evolution—that everything in the universe exists through natural causes without any supernatural input by a Creator God. You see, there are only two choices—evolution or creation.

If evolution is not true, then the only alternative is special creation by an intelligent Creator. If there is no Creator, then there is no foundation for the Gospel, and we can forget the Bible as a guide for

life. This is why there is such a need for *Creation Museum of the Ozarks* to be raised up as a testimony to the truth of creation by a Creator God.

BARRY: Thanks, Rod. We are looking forward to the day when *Creation Museum of the Ozarks* becomes a reality.
